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All retriever working tests will be held under Kennel Club Regulations J.

All dogs must be registered with the Kennel Club and their Kennel Club registration number must be included on the entry form otherwise the entry will be deemed void according to KC regulations. Inoculations should be up to date. Any dog which has contracted or been knowingly exposed to any infectious disease during the 21 days prior to the day of the Test should not be brought to the Test. Bitches in season will not be allowed on the ground. Dogs that are out of control; or whine at tests may, at the discretion of the Judges, be excluded from further competition on the day.

- Members entry fee £12, non-member fee £24.
- Late entries are at the discretion of the WT secretary and a late entry fee of £24 will apply.
- The draw will be published seven days before the test
- Refunds will only be made if a dog is withdrawn more than 7 days before the test
- A separate cheque must be sent for each dog and for each test
- A separate form must be completed for each test i.e. do not enter a novice walked-up on same form as the open walked-up
- No dog may be entered in to both the Novice & Open Walked-Up
- To enable as many handlers as possible to compete, if you, the handler, are entering both the Novice & Open Walked-Up please indicate a preference as to which you would prefer to run in i.e. if your preference is to run in the Open, you may be on the reserve list for the Novice and vice versa
- Preference will be given to KVGTS members
- Substitutions will be allowed but they must be on the original entry form and be of a similar standard dog.
- Second dogs entered in their own right (i.e. not as a substitution) will be put to the end of the reserve list
- Please complete qualification section for open dogs
- Entries not complying with the KVGTS retriever working test rules may be refused (ref: J7.d)

Definition:

OPEN Walked-up on FT Lines (unclassified) : Open to all dogs of a specific breed or breeds, although preference may be given to dogs which have gained a place or Certificate of Merit at a Field Trial, been placed First, Second or Third in an Open GWT, or won a Novice GWT. (Please ensure you complete the qualification section of the entry form.)

NOVICE Walked-up on FT Lines (unclassified) : Confined to dogs which have not gained a place or Certificate of Merit at a Field Trial, been placed First, Second or Third in an Open GWT, or First in a Novice GWT held in accordance with Kennel Club Rules and Field Trial Regulations. Nor to have been placed first in any novice walked up on FT lines.
